

Basic Safety Rules

- It is very important that Hirers are confident in the use of the All-Terrain Wheelchair and thoroughly familiarise themselves with its safe operation before taking it out of the hire centre.
- Wheels should be in the forward position during transfer. Wheel locks should also be engaged whenever the wheelchair is on a slope and an attendant is not present.
- DO NOT step on the footrest during transfer as this could cause the wheelchair to tip. Raise the armrests, entering and exiting the chair from the side ONLY. ENSURE that the wheel locks are engaged during transfer.
- DO NOT use the armrests during transfer.
- Know your own limitations in terms of strength and endurance before attempting any manoeuvres. e.g. negotiating a ramp or slope.
- Please note that the wheel locks are NOT brakes.
- Do not submerge the wheelchair in water.
- When in the wheelchair, use a sunscreen or an umbrella to avoid sunburn.
- The wheelchair frame can become hot when left outdoors during hot weather.
- For smooth turning on soft terrain, push down on the hand grips.
- The wheelchair is designed for use on the beach, where it is much easier to control than on hard surfaces. Its use on pavements should therefore be restricted to travelling to and from the beach (this will also save tyre wear).

Terms & Conditions

- The Hirer will pay a refundable deposit of £25.00.
- The Hirer must complete a hire form before the wheelchair is released for hire.
- Hirers accept and use the wheelchair completely at their own risk.
- Hirers must ensure that the wheelchair is suitable for their needs and that they are able to transfer into it safely.
- The Hirer will return the wheelchair to the point from which it was collected.
- The Hirer must take full responsibility for the wheelchair and return it in good condition by the agreed time.
- The Hirer will be responsible for any damages sustained whilst on hire. An inspection of the equipment will be made upon its return.
- Brighton & Hove City Council reserves the right to refuse the loan of equipment.

Did You Know?

- The chairs use four low pressure inflatable tyres to navigate our shingle shores
- The chairs are made from stainless steel and have different seating options to meet your posture needs – please ask for advice.
- The chairs can also have an umbrella attached to protect you from the sun and rain!
- Pushing down on the hand grips enables the chair to turn easily on the pebbles.



Brighton & Hove City Council is continually improving access to our facilities and services and we hope that the introduction of the all-terrain wheelchairs will give residents and visitors more opportunities to explore our beaches.

How to book/hire the chairs

- Two All-Terrain chairs are available from the Brighton & Hove Seafront Office (for contact details, see right).
- Bookings can be made up to one week in advance, or you can request a chair on the day of your visit.
- Proof of I.D. will be required when collecting the chair.
- On collection, you will also be required to complete a booking form, pay a £25.00 refundable deposit, and sign a consent form.
- Your own wheelchair can be stored safely while you use the All-Terrain chair.
- Basic safety rules (see overleaf) must be adhered to when using the chair.
- Please contact the Seafront Office if you expect your collection time to be delayed by more than 15 minutes. If the Office is not informed, your booking may be cancelled.
- Please see the Terms and Conditions of hire overleaf.
