Consent for Disposal of Metal Implants

Please read this form carefully before signing

In respect of the cremated remains of the late:

I, being the Applicant for the cremation of the above-named deceased person, hereby authorise the Manager of Woodvale Crematorium to recover any metal implants found amongst the cremated remains and to arrange for their disposal, as I have specified on this form.

Arrange for the metal implants to be recycled

After cremation, any metals present will be removed from the cremated remains and held at Woodvale Crematorium. Periodically, all metal recovered in this manner will be collected and taken to a central point within the UK for recycling.

OrthoMetals is a company nationally appointed to carry out the collection and recycling of metals on a non-commercial, open accounting basis.

Any surplus monies derived from the recycling scheme will be distributed amongst selected UK Charities with confirmation from such Charities posted on www.iccm-uk.com, which is the website of the Institute of Cemetery and Crematorium Management.

Arrange for the metal implants to be returned to myself, the Applicant for Cremation, without the cremated remains

Any metals recovered form part of a deceased person's estate. The Executor may, therefore, wish to dispose of the metals in an alternative manner.

Arrange for the metal implants to be returned to myself, the Applicant for Cremation, with the cremated remains

Any metals recovered, form part of a deceased person's estate. The Executor may, therefore, wish to dispose of the metals in an alternative manner. If this option is chosen, the cremated remains cannot be strewn.

Please note that soft metals, such as gold and silver, melt into tiny globules following cremation and are not identifiable. In these circumstances it is not possible to return these metals to the applicant separately. It is recommended that precious metals in the form of jewellery are retained by the Applicant for Cremation and not cremated with the deceased.

It is important that this form is returned to Woodvale prior to the cremation proceeding in order that the wishes of the Applicant for Cremation may be complied with.
